

Loup Railport Operator Health & Safety Compliance

Safety is a top priority for Loup Logistics Company, including our railports. Our railport operators are required to enforce Loup's rules, standards and practices for maintaining a safe work environment. This includes, among other things, being familiar with and obeying all rules and regulations applicable to their duties and work locations, and being responsible for its personnel being prepared to work in compliance with all applicable standards and requirements – keeping our railports free from safety and health hazards.

To that end, please consider Section 4 of our Railport Operator Agreements to include the following compliance requirement to address safety and health hazard issues:

Loup Logistics Company is a federal contractor or subcontractor. Consequently, if applicable, Operator shall comply with the requirements of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.223-99 Ensuring Adequate COVID-19 Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors, including, but not limited to, all guidance, including guidance conveyed through Frequently Asked Questions, as amended during the performance of this Agreement, that is published by the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force (Task Force Guidance) at <https://www.saferfederalworkforce.gov/contractors/>. Additionally, Operator shall include the substance of this clause, including this sentence, in subcontracts under this Agreement at any tier that exceed the simplified acquisition threshold, as defined in Federal Acquisition Regulation 2.101 on the date of subcontract award and are for services, including construction, performed in whole or in part within the United States or its outlying areas (as defined in FAR 52.223-99).
